Order

AND WHEREAS, Tamilnadu, for grant of recognition to K.S.M College of Education for women Therkkutheru Meru Taluk, Madurai District-625122, Tamilnadu for B.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 Students on 27.12.2005 with the condition that the institution shall shift to its own premises/building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is stated in rented premises)

AND WHEREAS, the application was processed as per the provisions of the NCTE Rules and Regulations, Norms and Standards prevalent at that point of time and the recognition was granted to the institution vide order dated 27.12.2005 with certain stipulated conditions.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC in its 175th meeting held on 13th -14th May, 2009, the office of SRC has reviewed the files of the institutions which had been granted recognition either in rented premises pending construction of own building or in leased premises.

AND WHEREAS, a list of such institutions were prepared and placed before SRC in its 181st meeting held on 20th - 21st August 2009, wherein it was decided that the institutions which have not shifted to the permanent premises even after the expiry of three years time limit, be issued notice under section 17 of NCTE Act for further action

AND WHEREAS, notice was issued to the institution on 15.09.2009. The institution submitted its representation on 01.10.2009.

AND WHEREAS, on 31.12.2014 letters were issued to all existing institutions regarding notification of new Regulations, 2014 seeking consent on their willingness for fulfilling the revised norms and standards before 31.10.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its willingness affidavit on 25.05.2015 as per Regulations 2014. Accordingly, revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 29.05.2015 for an annual intake 100 students for two basic units of 50 students each with a condition that the institution not maintained revalidated FDR's.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted written representation on 09.06.2015 which was placed before SRC in its 291st Meeting held on 20th-21st August 2015. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. Additional unit has to be in the same premises as that of the basic unit.
2. The 2008 inspection of the additional unit can, therefore, be taken as inspection of the basic unit also.
3. There is no need to persist with the shifting clause in the recognition order.
4. Issue Revised Recognition order.
5. Cause inspection after 31 Oct, 2015 to ensure full compliance of the 2014 Regulations.

AND WHEREAS, as per the direction of the SRC, inspection of the institution was fixed between 10th-30th January, 2016. The same was intimated to the institution on 11.01.2016. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 22.01.2016 VT report received in this office of SRC-NCTE on 01.02.2016.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 301st Meeting held on 05th-06th February, 2016 considered the VT report and other relevant documents and decided that **Shifting be permitted for B.Ed basic unit APS03629**. As per the decision of SRC, a shifting order was issued to the institution on 22.03.2016

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 314th meeting held on 27th and 28th May, 2016 considered the matter and decided as under:

- *“For cases of B.Ed (2 Units) in the existing institution, where RPRO, has been issued, we have to cause inspection to check adherence to the 2014 Regulations. This action will have to be completed by July 2016 so that revised Formal Recognition can be issued w.e.f. 2016-17 to enable them to make admission in time.*
- *Action to check the documents in these cases (about 1885 in number) will take time. Instead of Waiting for that action to be completed for placing them before the SRC, to save time, VT Inspections can straightaway be ordered. VT Inspection Report can be considered along with examination of the documents.*
- *Regional Director is authorized to initiate action accordingly. The institution concerned may be alerted about such action so that they will be prepared to receive the Visiting Teams. They may also be advised to keep in readiness latest approved Faculty Lists for Submission to the VTs.”*

AND WHEREAS, inspection intimation letter was issued to the institution on 27.06.2016

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted a letter dated 04.07.2016, received on 08.07.2016, along with relevant documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 319th meeting held on 30th -31st August 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. For B.Ed (2 units) and B.Ed-A.I (2 units), they need 3000 sq.mtrs .They have only 2544 sq.mtrs
2. Please process the documents on record and report.
3. Thereafter, issue a composite SCN for withdrawal of recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted the land and building documents vide letter dated 27.10.2015, received on 31.10.2015. The same was placed before SRC in its 323th meeting held on 16th-18st November 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. The only problem now in this case is inadequate build-up area. They have proposed reduction of the intake level to be accommodated in the available area.
2. They have B.Ed (2 units) and B.Ed-AI (2 Units). In the available area, they can have B.Ed (2 units) and B.Ed-AI (1 unit).
3. They have agreed to any closure. Permit closure of B.Ed-Ai(1 unit). Withdraw recognition of one unit of B.Ed-AI w.e.f 2016-17.



4. They have not submitted the faculty list. They have also not given FDRs in full. Ask them to remove these deficiencies before we can consider issue of revised FR for B.Ed (2 units) and B.Ed-AI(1 unit).

NOW THEREFORE, the recognition of **K.S.M College of Education for women Therkkutheru Meru Taluk, Madurai District-625122, Tamilnadu** for (B.Ed-AI) Course (APS08851) of the 2nd units is hereby **withdrawn** w.e.f 2016-2017 as per request of the institution and the institution has now thus **Three units of 50 students** each (2 units of B.Ed (APS03629) and 1 unit of B.Ed –AI (APS08851)) to conduct the B.Ed course.

If the institution contravenes any of the conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and order made or issued there under, the regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provision as under the provisions of section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
